CONSENSUS VIEW (GB) dropped back after the start, moved in to save ground on the first turn, settled at the rear, was roused in the two path on the far turn, raced behind foes inside the five-sixteenths pole, rallied in the five path into the stretch and closed strongly to get up late and prevail. CHARTIST was taken in hand while showing speed outside of PRIME CONNECTION, prompted the pace on the outside while a path detached from the leader, took the advantage late on the backstretch, vied in the three then two path while let out on the far turn, was put to a drive in upper stretch, led into the final sixteenth but was caught while able to get the place. STAND THE RAIN dropped back early, moved from the two path to the three path on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, came under urging around the seven-sixteenths pole, chased in the three then four path on the far turn, pursued the leader under a drive in the stretch and kept on willingly to get the show. MARY LOIS (IRE) dropped back early, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled on the outside, was roused in the two then three path on the far turn, turned into upper stretch under a drive and lacked the needed kick. PRIME CONNECTION showed speed on the inside of CHARTIST, set the pace on the inside while in hand, lost the lead narrowly late on the backstretch, vied inside on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, battled under a drive into the final furlong, dropped back outside the sixteenth-pole and weakened. MIEL ET CITRON saved ground while reserved off the pace, came under encouragement just inside the half-mile pole, raced inside into the stretch and failed to respond.

LADY WISDOM coaxed from the gate, dueled five paths off the inside down the backstretch with MOONLIT WEEKEND to her inside, tucked three wide through the turn coming under coaxing three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, took over command nearing the eighth pole, dug in and held safe to the finish. BLENHEIM BABY grew detached at the tail of the field when devoid of speed early on, chased three then two wide coming under a ride with seven-sixteenths to go, spun three wide into upper stretch and kicked on belatedly to the finish. POCKET QUEENS coaxed from the start, raced seven paths off the inside down the backstretch just off the duel up front, tucked four wide into the turn and advanced on those rivals latching on midway on the turn, swung six wide into upper stretch, kept on to the wire. MOONLIT WEEKEND dueled from the two path with the top one to her outside, came under coaxing at the five-sixteenths under challenge from a pair of rivals, went four wide into upper stretch, dug in under a drive and was collared nearing the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages. THAT'STHEFACTJACK chased five to six paths off the inside down the backstretch and then three wide through the turn under urging with seven-sixteenths to go, went seven wide into upper stretch and weakened.

ROSEBERNS DREAM moved in while hustled to the front, showed the way while well rated in the two path, responded well when asked at the top of the stretch, came under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker, switched to a left-handed crop under heavy threat outside the sixteenth-pole and held gamely under strong urging. NO NEED TO PANIC showed speed between horses then was taken under restraint, stalked the pace on the outside in the three path, was given her cue on the far turn, chased outside into the final furlong then made a bid, reached within a neck of the winner into the final sixteenth but was turned away and denied while able to get the place. ISLAND CHARM broke out and brushed the gate, was taken under a snug hold early then rated just off the pace on the inside, continued to save ground while asked on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the two path then moved further out, pursued the top two to the finish and showed good courage for the show. AMICUS CURIAE was taken in hand early, raced in the two then three path on the first turn, was rated just off the pace with cover, rounded the far turn in the three path while asked, chased in the four path into the stretch, angled further out while in pursuit of the leaders inside the three-sixteenths pole, chased in the drive and lacked the needed kick while just able to get the last spot in the superfecta. ADDAGIRL ADDIE reared at the start and was off slow, spotted the front a few lengths, saved ground while settled off the pace, was asked on the far turn, chased under a drive in the stretch and also lacked the needed kick then just missed the superfecta. FIND YOUR PATH bobbled at the start then dropped back early, moved from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, settled outside without cover, tucked in behind cover just inside the half-mile pole, was roused in the three path on the far turn, came out to the seven path into the stretch then moved further out and failed to rally. MIA SOPHIA was taken under restraint early, dropped from the three path to the two path early on the first turn, was reserved off the pace, raced in the two path while roused on the far turn, came out to the five path into the stretch, remained on her inside lead in the drive and lacked the needed response. NINA LEE

was off slow and spotted the front a few lengths, rounded the first turn in the two path, settled at rear, saved ground while roused on the far turn, spun into the stretch in the two path then moved further out and failed to threaten.

PROUD FOOT was hustled from the gate, stalked the pace on the outside, inched closer in the four path on the turn, took a short lead into upper stretch, led under a drive to the sixteenth-pole then was headed by the winner, fought on to the finish but just missed while clear for the place. DESPO'S DREAM settled on the outside, was urged along in the two path on the turn, spun into the stretch in the three path then angled out and improved with late energy to get the show. CITY BLOCKS went to the front then showed the way, was urged along in the two path while inside of two opponents for most of the turn then dropped to the rail, lost the advantage into upper stretch, chased into the final furlong, dropped back into the final sixteenth and weakened. SCORCH broke in at the start briefly carrying in ARTISTIC SUCCESS, chased along the inside under urging from the five-sixteenths marker, spun just off the inside into upper stretch, ran on to secure the place honors. ARTISTIC SUCCESS got carried in briefly by SCORCH just after the start, chased along the inside under encouragement from the three-eighths pole, cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, kept on to the finish. ROCKYTA broke in at the start bumping FIFI LA FUME just after the break, chased just off the inside under urging with five-sixteenths to go, swung three wide into upper stretch and improved position to the wire. FIFI LA FUME got bumped after the start by the aforementioned foe breaking inwards, chased along the inside patiently handled until let out taking the inside route into upper stretch, then passed tired rivals to the end. HEADS IN BEDS (FR) chased three then two wide in closest aim of the leader, got roused spinning just off the inside into upper stretch, flirted with command when overtaken by the top one a furlong out, then weakened through to the finish. LUPINE showed the way lightly coaxed along the inside, got set down taking the inside route into upper stretch, got collared a furlong out and weakened through to the end. Following a shoe repair in the paddock,

GRESHAM'S LAW got coaxed from the start, chased four then three wide under a ride with five-sixteenths remaining, cornered four wide at the head of the stretch and came up empty. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
