OPEN SOUL AUTISM chased along the inside coming under coaxing near the quarter pole, continued along the inside into upper stretch, rallied up the rail to take command just outside the eighth pole, then edged clear to the finish to prevail. SHEZANARCTICQUEEN showed the way in hand just off the inside coming under a ride near the quarter pole, swung four then three wide into upper stretch, straightened away to the two path under challenge to the inside and was caught just outside the eighth pole, then weakened in the late stages while just preserving the place honors on the wire. THELASTBULLETSMINE brushed the off side stall at the start and was corrected, chased four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, tipped six wide into upper stretch, weakened in the late going. BEST IMPRESSION coaxed from the gate, chased three wide under urging from three furlongs out, angled four to five wide for home, weakened in the late stages.

SPINNING CLASS was taken in hand early, saved ground on the first turn, was rated just off the pace, moved from the two path to the four path while roused on the far turn, rallied outside in upper stretch, closed strongly under a right-handed crop to get the lead outside the furlong marker and drew away under steady urging to prove much the best. MAPPY broke out but came out in front, went around the first turn in the two then three path, showed the way well off the inside, moved in late on the backstretch, vied in the two path while inside of a rival on the far turn, was asked near the quarter-pole, drifted out while put to a right-handed crop in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner outside the furlong marker and proved no match while keeping on well to hold the place. KEF dropped off the pace, was taken in hand nearing the first turn, saved ground under reserve, was urged along on the far turn, drifted out under a left-handed crop in upper stretch, moved in under a right-handed crop outside the furlong marker and was along for the show. TWO BY TWO BY TWO broke out then was hustled, moved up while taken in hand on the outside, raced in the four path on the first turn, prompted the pace on the outside of the leader, moved in late on the backstretch, vied in the three path while asked on the far turn, was carried out in upper stretch, dropped back into the final furlong and tired. ESSENCE L VEE was last away then grabbed with the right-rein while having her path taken by MAPPY, saved ground on the first turn, settled unhurried at the rear, was urged along in the two path on the far turn, spun into the stretch under the crop and failed to respond. DREAMY GIRL dropped back early, raced in the three path on the first turn, settled outside but with some cover, was urged along late on the backstretch, retreated to the rear in the three path on the far turn and faltered then was eased in the final furlong but walked off.

CALLING CARD broke in at the start under coaxing, chased four then three wide advancing on the leader through the turn coming under coaxing and taking command near the quarter pole, swung six wide into upper stretch, drew clear under a drive to inside the eighth pole before being taken in hand just outside the sixteenth pole to finish comfortably while still drawing off to the wire. THE OBLITERATOR chased five wide under urging from the seven-sixteenths pole, angled seven to eight wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one while keeping on to procure the place honors. DUCKY MEDWICK broke in at the start under hustling, advanced to take command six furlongs from home, showed the way in hand just off the inside, came under increasing pressure through the turn getting placed to coaxing three furlongs out, yielded the front nearing the quarter pole and cornered just off the inside into upper stretch, weakened in the late stages. WHITBY led early on before being displaced from command by the aforementioned foe, chased three then four wide under a ride from the seven-sixteenths marker, went four wide into upper stretch and weakened. RAGING SEA CAPTAIN coaxed from the gate, chased just off the inside and then along the inside under encouragement from the three-eighths pole, spun three wide into upper stretch, tired.

ELIMINATE settled on the outside, went around most of the turn in the four path then moved to the five path, rallied in the seven path into the stretch, closed strongly under a strong-hand ride to get the lead outside the sixteenth-pole then went clear under hand urging to the finish. GENERAL BANKER was hustled from the gate, established a good position just off the pace, chased in the two path on the turn, pursued the leaders under a drive in the stretch and just got up for the place. OTELLO was bumped at the start and forced out into another foe, went to the front, showed the way well out in the course, vied in the three to four path on the turn, was asked outside the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch in the five path then battled inside of MR. PAPAGIORGIO, lost the advantage to that opponent at the furlong marker and was outfinished then just missed the place but narrowly earned the show. MR. PAPAGIORGIO stumbled badly at the start and had the rider lose his right iron, regained the iron before going a sixteenth of a mile, moved up to track the pace on the outside, was asked in the four to five path on the turn, made a bid outside the five-sixteenths pole, came into the stretch in the six path then battled outside of OTELLO, led narrowly into the final furlong but was out-kicked then just missed the superfecta. PLAYING TRICKS was hustled from the gate then urged along off the pace, traveled around the turn in the two path, was driven into the stretch in the three path under the crop and lacked the needed response. RANGER BATTALION came out then bumped with a foe at the start, settled near the back, angled in with five furlongs to run, was urged along in the three path on the turn, came into the stretch in the four path and failed to threaten. MAKES SENSE broke out a tad, pressed the pace down the backstretch, chased inside on the turn and tired. LOU settled off the pace, angled in near the five-eighths pole, saved ground under urging on the turn and failed to respond.

SULTAN HASSAN pressed the pace of the aforementioned foe two then three wide under a ride from the five-sixteenths pole, spun two to three wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the top one and held on to preserve the place honors over a rival at the finish. DAISY DOO chased two then three wide under coaxing from three furlongs out, angled five wide into upper stretch, offered up a mild bid. TAKEITEASY CHARLIE brushed the near side stall at the start, chased along the inside and then just off the inside under urging from three furlongs out, angled four wide into upper stretch and improved position to the finish. BUBSTER chased three then two wide under encouragement from three furlongs out, tipped four wide into upper stretch and weakened in the late stages. PORTADOWN LAD chased three then four wide under urging from the three-eighths pole, angled five to six wide into upper stretch and made no impact. HOW MUCH IS ENOUGH hustled from the start, chased four wide under a ride from three furlongs out, angled six wide into upper stretch and tired. MR. POOLS led early on before vying briefly with the top pair, then chased along the inside under encouragement from the three-eighths pole, spun just off the inside into upper stretch and tired.
