BOSTONTONIAN went to the front then showed the way, moved from the rail to the two path on the turn, came out to the four path into upper stretch then was asked, moved in closer to the runner-up outside the eighth-pole, responded well in the final furlong and held under steady urging. YO BANANA BOY raced just off the pace, dropped back late on the backstretch, moved from the three path to the two path on the turn, was roused near the three-sixteenths-pole, chased the winner into the final sixteenth and was second best. FACTUALLY CORRECT was hustled from the gate then tracked the pace, went around the turn in the two then three path, was roused near the five-sixteenths pole, chased the top two in the stretch and lacked the needed kick while clear for the show. BRACIOLE showed no speed under urging, dropped well behind the rest of the field, saved ground on the turn, moved out in the stretch and finished with late energy to just get the last spot in the superfecta. STEWIE broke out and bumped with a foe then steadied in tight quarters, was ridden along on the far outside, angled in late on the backstretch, dropped from the two path to the inside early on the turn, came out into upper stretch and lacked the needed response. I'M WIDE AWAKE was bumped at the start, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn and tired.
