CHUMMERS was well rated early, two to three path on the turn and inching closer nearing the bend, swung out five wide leaving the turn and made a bid to go on even terms by the furlong marker and drove clear after a couple left handed pops with the crop then was ridden out late to prove best while clear. THIRSTED was well rated on the inside, moved closer on the turn and swung out four wide leaving the turn to make a bid but was out-finished in the final furlong by the winner but clearly second best. HOITY MORONI vied for the early lead two wide the shook clear and moved to the inside on the turn, was headed by the quarter pole and relented the lead, then proved to be no match for the top two wide coming back again late to claim the show award. TRUE LEGEND was bumped in the hind end leaving the gate, vied for the lead on the inside by the half mile marker, then was rated off the lead and moved out on the turn to make a two to three wide bid to go on even terms by the quarter pole, had a short lead by the three sixteenths and was headed by the furlong marker and faded losing the show award very late. KID RICH was settled early and three wide on the turn, came five wide into the lane but had no rally. BABY MEANIE was reserved along the inside, moved off the inside by the five sixteenths and swung out seven wide leaving the turn but offered no rally while being no threat. BRILLIANT FURY hesitated at the break, then bumped a rivals hind end, reserved early and raced two to four wide on the turn, swung out eight wide leaving the turn and never factored.
