SOLDIER'S GLORY settled off the pace, was roused in the five then six path on the turn, rallied outside into upper stretch, closed strongly to get the lead outside the furlong marker, went clear outside the sixteenth-pole, drifted out some when threatened by the runner-up late and just held under strong urging. FIERCE HOPE dropped back while urged along early then settled off the pace, was roused while saving ground on the turn, swung out to the five path into upper stretch, rallied outside into the final furlong and closed with a rush to just miss while well clear for the place. NEPTUNEROAD RICHIE disputed the pace between horses, dropped back late on the backstretch, chased in the four then three path on the turn, pursued the leader under a drive into the final furlong and weakened but held the show. SARATOGA TEA was urged along off the pace, went around the turn in the four to five path, gained into the stretch, chased under a drive into the final furlong and flattened out. TARTAH broke in and hit the gate, chased the pace on the outside then in the four path on the turn and tired. FREEDOM CHARGE veered in at the start, was urged along off the pace, rounded the turn in the three path, swung out to the six path

into upper stretch and failed to threaten. A LOT OF GOLD was a bit slow into stride, raced towards the rear under urging, went around most of the turn in the two path then shifted to the four path, came out to the seven path into upper stretch and was no factor. MENDEL showed speed on the outside then set the pace, moved in late on the backstretch, went clear with three furlongs to run, vied in the two path on the turn, led under a drive in upper stretch, lost the advantage to the winner outside the furlong marker and gave way. BILLY BUCCHERO broke a bit slow then ducked in and was taken up, moved from the inside to the five path on the turn, came into upper stretch in the eight path and never reached contention. SPHINX was hustled from the gate, contested the pace on the inside of three foes, dropped back leaving the backstretch, chased inside to the two path on the turn and came up empty. PRIVATE BANKER bumped with NEVER BEFORE at the start, chased the pace, went around the turn in the two path and capitulated. NEVER BEFORE bumped with PRIVATE BANKER at the start, contested the pace between horses, dropped back late on the backstretch, retreated in the three path on the turn and faltered then was eased but walked off.
