SIR WALTA stumbled in the hindquarters at the start, tracked the pace on the outside then in the three path on the turn, was asked inside the five-sixteenths pole, rallied to the lead outside the eighth-pole, responded well in the final furlong and edged clear under strong urging to prove best. DAISY DOO settled near the middle of the field, was roused in the two then three path on the turn, came into the stretch in the four path, pursued two rivals in the drive and finished willingly to get up for the place. MAIN THING showed speed from the outside and set the pace on the outside of STORY OF RORY, moved to a solo lead coming to the half-mile pole, dropped from the two path to the inside while controlling the action on the turn, was asked outside the quarter-pole then came under a drive, lost the lead to the winner outside the furlong marker, dropped back into the final sixteenth then swapped back to her inside lead and weakened then suffered an injury to his right hind leg after the finish and was euthanized on the course. STORY OF RORY was hustled from the gate, pressed the pace on the inside while in hand, dropped back a length behind the leader with a half-mile to run, saved ground on the turn, was roused nearing the quarter-pole, moved out in upper stretch and lacked the needed kick. KLIMT MASTER bumped a foe with his hindquarters at the start, dropped back then settled near the rear, saved ground while roused on the turn and failed to rally. SHENANIGANS BUCK paused while in tight inside the eleven-sixteenths pole then dropped back, settled near the back, was roused in the three path on the turn and was no factor. LOMBARDO bumped with a rival at the start while last away then was pinched back, settled on the outside without cover, was roused in the four path on the turn, came into the stretch in the five path and failed to respond.
