UP TO NO GOOD tracked the pace from the inside, loomed along the inside of the far turn to take charge at the quarter, drove clear in the stretch. MYSTANDARDS pressed the pace from the two path in the first turn, chased between runners up the backstretch, got up for the place award in the late stages. ALTER BOY quickly took charge before the first turn, met a challenge by J SQUARED to vie for command up the backstretch, reclaimed sole command at the top of the far turn before giving way to the winner at the quarter, gave way to one more and held for the show award. JUS TOO FLY found a forward position four wide, had no closing bid. DU MONDE settled off the pace on the inside, shifted out four wide rounding the far turn but could not rally. HALTER BOY broke a step slow, trailed for most, made some minor improvements late. NORTHSIDE TAP tracked the pace three wide between runners, retreated through the far turn. J SQUARED was off a beat slow, advanced through traffic to vie with ALTER BOY up the backstretch, began retreating in the far turn and trailed by the three sixteenths.
