MESS HALL tracked the pace three wide, closed in through the turn and split foes at the top of the stretch, kicked clear of the rest. AMADOR chased the pace in the early stages, ranged up through the turn to split the rail at the top of the stretch contested the lead in the upper stretch but was ultimately no match for the winner, held for the place award. MAN OF THE HOUR settled off the pace, rallied well through traffic and came up just short of the place award. CAN OF CORN was fractious in the starting gate, stalked the early pace setter, contested the lead four wide with three others at the top of the stretch but came up empty. MORE THAN PRADA settled off the pace, entered the stretch in the five path, made improvements. DURABLE got pinched back at the start, trailed for most, finished well through traffic in the stretch. DRESS GOOD was forwardly placed in the early stages, failed to menace. WHISKY RESERVE settled off the pace on the inside, shifted out at in the upper stretch, could not rally. JANEY'S FLYIN quickly claimed a ground saving lead just off the rail, found himself between bids at the top of the lane and gave way, weakened then on. BLUEGRASS DOMAIN was squeezed back at the

start, never threatened. TREBLEWITHTHECURVE found early position around the middle of the pack, lacked a response, retreated. THIRD FRACTIONAL TIME IS PENDING REVIEW.
