R U ENTICED settled off the pace, surged just off the rail along her inside lead after the turn for home, took charge at the eighth and kept on to widen her winning margin. MISS ELECKTRA chased the early pace setter, was cued rounding the far turn to take charge at the top of the lane, led briefly before giving way to an inner rival at the eighth marker. ECHO VALLEY settled off the pace, began to quickly gain through the far turn, finished well five wide to earn the show award. NAVA'S GOLD was forwardly placed in the two path, appeared to jump a shadow at the seven sixteenths, gained in the upper stretch but was a bit uncooperative in the final furlong and got overtaken at the wire to miss out on the show. PERFECT ANGEL tracked the pace three wide, flattened out in the late stages. JASPER MAXIMUS showed good early speed, met a bid from MISS ELECKTRA rounding the far turn and gave way at the top of the stretch, proceeded to fade quickly. SWEET KYLIE got pinched back at the start, made some improvements along the outside of the far turn but could do no more in the stretch. NO NAPPING found position around the middle of the pack, was steadied around the seven sixteenths to avoid NAVA'S GOLD, showed little in the late stages. BOURBON N BLUSH raced off the pace, made no impact. STORM SEARCH tracked the pace four wide in the early stages, through after half. WEELASSIE settled between runners, was through after half.
