AMADOR showed the way while uncontested from along the inside, came under pressure midway around the turn, and kicked on down the lane to hold clear. DURABLE chased in the four path, improved under a ride in the three path around the turn, took aim at the top of the lane, and ran on to be second best. BRAHMS HALO was prompted from up close in the two path, driven around the turn, but finished evenly down the lane for show. TLAHUICOLE had a slow start, trailed in the four path and made no impact from the five path in the stretch. ROADSWITCHER rated in the three path, was ridden in the two path around the turn, but weakened down the lane.
