BOOMING tracked in the four path, was ridden in the three path around the far turn, angled inside at the top of the stretch, kicked on to bid passing the furlong grounds, and drew ahead in the final sixteenth. SARGEANT BARGER set the pace in the two path, was cued passing the quarter, kept on from the three path down the stretch, but got edged out by the inner winner in the final sixteenth. BURNING LEAVES had a slow start, stalked in the four path, was roused from the three path passing the three-eighths pole, took aim in the four path at the top od the lane, but faded. THISPOINTINTIME prompted the pace inside, was coaxed from the rail midway around the far turn, but retreated in the stretch.
