DU MONDE tracked the leaders from the second flight to the far turn, rallied on the turn to prominence, angled three wide splitting rivals turning for home to engage the leader in upper stretch, dueled through the stretch and prevailed late in the drive. S J B EXPRESS pressed the pace from between horses from the half mile pole to midway on the far turn when he assumed command while still in hand, responded to battle the winner when challenged and was outfinished in the final yards while a clear second best. J SQUARED set the pace on a clear early lead, came under pressure at the half mile pole, continued on the lead under steady pressure to the five-sixteenths pole, could not go with the top pair and ran-on through the lane to hold the show. BORIS BADENOV reserved at the rear of the trailing trio for the first half, ranged up five wide on the final turn and failed to sustain his bid in the lane finishing evenly. FRAME UP prompted the pace from four wide to the turn, rallied to be well placed turning for home and flattened out in the stretch. FORT BLING was rank while racing in tight quarters along the rail for the first three-eighths, dropped to the rear of the field and was outrun coming home.

TOM'S AVATAR reserved off the pace at the back of the main body of the field, made a steady advance closing the gap to mid-stretch, found his best stride late and surged in time in the final yards. TAP THE CARD JACK pressed the pace to the turn, assumed command on the bend, opened a clear lead in the lane, stalled when on the lead alone waiting for competition and was nailed on the wire. SKYTREE stalked the leaders down the backside, rallied nearing the quarter pole, was unable to pass the runner-up and ran-on through the lane. TAP THE WIND set the pace under pressure for three-eighths and weakened fading from contention. PARTY BOY was away slowly from the gate and never proved a factor. This race had a timing error or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times available.

BOWLING HEIGHTS reserved off the quick early pace, commenced a steady advance midway down the backstretch, closed the gap on the turn, took command midway down the lane to go clear from the weakening pacesetter and was ridden out in the final hundred yards. EXPONENTIALLY sped to the lead into the first turn, opened a clear advantage on the bend, maintained that lead while setting quick fractions, responded when called upon turning for home and weakened in the final eighth while finishing as second best. VANADIUM chased the clear pacesetter in a pocket of his own, gained ground on the far turn to contend at the top of the lane and kept-on willingly holding the show. DREAM BOY unhurried in the early going to be well off the pace and rallied turning for home with good late interest. LOW STANDARDS raced mid-pack to the far turn, rallied mildly on the far turn, was fanned eight wide at the head of the stretch and flattened out in the lane. COOL LUCKY passed tiring rivals in the stretch. SCARED CAUSE saved ground to no avail lacking a closing bid. MONEY MAGIC broke alertly, was taken in hand to settle to a tracking position and faded from contention on the final turn.
