RANCH LIFE raced off the pace, moved up two wide on the backside, bid three wide on the far turn, took over, responded when roused, pulled away under urging and was in hand the final strides. POLA OF TROUBLE tracked on the inside, chased on the far turn, came four wide into the lane and rallied outside for second. TUENDA raced off the pace, moved up three wide on the far turn, rallied mildly and was outfinished for second. MARKET OF STOCKS set the pace on the inside, dueled inside on the far turn and faded. PEACHES POINT had the rider lose the irons after the start and never recovered them, made a middle move on the backside, dueled between rivals on the far turn and gave way. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
