LEAVE IT TO KITTEN steadied in the early stages, settled off the pace inside, chased on the far turn, came two wide into the lane, closed well late outside rivals and was up for the win. DAY TRIPPER set the pace on the inside, dueled on the far turn, shook free nearing the furlong marker, dug in gamely inside to the finish and held on for second. ROYALLY BITTER tracked on the inside, chased on the far turn, angled out at the top of the lane and rallied late between horses. SNOW KING stalked close up two wide, bid two wide on the far turn, dueled into the stretch and weakened. STEP ON IT raced two wide off the pace, came three wide into the lane and had no rally. STITZY was off slowly and outrun.
