GOOD POINT saved ground while being reserved off the pace, angled out three-wide leaving the quarter pole then angled back to the inside entering the stretch for room, took the lead at the eighth pole and gradually drew clear. BAYTOWN ANUBIS was allowed to settle racing two-wide, came three-wide into the stretch and finished well for second in a strong effort. J SQUARED saved ground setting the pace, drifted out slightly to be two-wide entering the stretch and held on well during the drive for the show. SPUNS SON was unhurried, moved forward racing three-wide nearing the three-eighths pole but was unable to sustain his bid during the drive. ORA CERTA settled in the middle of the field, came three-wide into the stretch and failed to seriously threaten. PHRASEOLOGISM saved ground racing in the back of the field and failed to be a factor. MY MISTER PERFECT prompted the early pace racing two-wide, stopped after a half and bled then was transported off the track via the equine ambulance. DUE TO A TIME MALFUNCTION THERE WAS NO MILE FRACTION AVAILABLE,
