LAMPORGHINI rated along the inside, eased up into the upper lane, three wide near the eighth pole and edged up late under strong handling. SILENT SKY stalked the pace, had an inside bid near the three sixteenths pole and finished gamely to the wire. LUCKY SHORE dropped back early, ridden from the inside near the quarter pole, shifted out four wide through the drive and rallied gamely to the wire. TRUE CLASS showed good early speed along the inside and weakened the final eighth of a mile. PEACHES POINT settled off the early going, four wide into the upper stretch and had no response. RETAIL THERAPY off slowly, lag to race well back early and never threatened. BLOSSOMING prompt the early leader two wide from the outside and stopped.
