ARGENTINIDAD settled off the early pace racing in hand, ridden into the far turn, closed in strongly racing six wide into the upper stretch and was well clear late under steady handling. LADIES LOVE CASH set her own uncontested early pace, challenged nearing the eighth pole and was no match for the winner. TIZ LAWS HALL tracked the early leader two deep and weakened a bit through the drive. EASY PEASY GIRL had an inside run and no late response. MS CONNIE'S PRAYER forwardly placed early and was done early. EASTER ON PARADE lost ground to race far back, eased through the stretch run and walked off. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
