SHOTGUN PRO dropped back early racing patiently, two wide through the far turn, shifted out six wide through the stretch run and surged up late under steady pressure. ANDY MAN CAN set a pressured early pace along the inside, cleared off near the quarter pole and missed in a game effort. BISHOPS CLEEVE off slowly, raced near the back after the slow start, two wide through the far turn, eased out five wide near the eighth pole and moved up late to improve position. TURANDOT chased the pace from the outside and weakened through the drive. LUCKCREST urged along, saved ground through the far turn and raced evenly to the wire. FOREIGN MINISTER pressed the pace between rivals and gave way. MR. ZAPPER dwelt at the start, lost a considerable amount of ground at the start, raced from the inside through the far turn and never menced.
