Starters and riders must be named through the entry box by the usual time of closing. This race will be limited to twelve (12) horses with preference to start given to those with the highest total earnings in 2025-2026. Should this race be determined to run on the dirt the distance will remain the same. Failure to draw in cancels all fees. Lasix is not permitted in this race. Trophy presented to the winningowner. AWESOMESAUCE settled off the early pace racing in hand while at the back of the pack, moved up strongly four wide through the far turn and surged clear late under steady handling. LIONISTIC set all the pace from the outside, overtaken late and kept on gamely to the wire. LA ARTISTA dropped back to race mid pack, moved up from the inside around the far turn into the lane and moved up to improve position. DERBY DAY KISS stalked the pace along the inside down the backstretch, aim into the upper lane but had not enough in the drive racing three wide. HERE'S THE SPIDER squeezed back at the start, raced mid pack after the poor start, three wide near the quarter pole and raced evenly with no closing run. JOSEFINA broke to the outside, bumped with rival,

raced with the second flight early, three wide near the quarter pole, eased out six wide into the upper lane and needed more in the drive. ELECTRIC MELODY settled early, had an inside run and no late response. GOOSEBUMPS bumped at the start, raced from the inside through the far turn into the lane and never threatened. LO BUG up close, settled down the backstretch racing in hand, swung seven wide into the lane and never threatened. CARMEL ROSE broke in, bumped at the start, forwardly placed early on and faded. R U ENTICED dropped back early and failed to menace.
