FORT BULL away well, vied initially with GOLDEN SURVIVOR and GLOBAL LEGEND for the early lead, went on through the turn with just the first named, put that foe away late on the turn, went to a clear lead despite racing on the wrong lead, but held the margin to the wire. GOLDEN SURVIVOR dueled to the inside of FORT BULL to the turn, gave way approaching the quarter pole, but kpted ton well to save the place. PAVED IN GOLD was content to be the trailer in the run down the backstretch, started to run on with three furlongs to go, came out four wide into the stretch, flattened out, but managed to outgame a rival for the minor award. GLOBAL LEGEND raced up close to the pace along the inside, dropped back near the seven-sixteenths marker, engaged in a spirited battle for the third prize, but came up short. FORT BLING settled well off the early pace, then lacked a late bid. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
