CEDRATO raced prominently three wide, moved to challenge approaching the three-eighths pole, wore down PEACHES POINT through the stretch and was up late. PEACHES POINT contested the pace along the inside, gained a clear advantage nearing the quarter pole, dug in through midstretch but could not hold off the winner late. RETAIL THERAPY was caught five wide on the first turn, settled near the rear but remained within striking distance, continued wide through the far turn and stayed on to earn the minor award. MORNING LINE NEWS briefly dueled two wide for the lead, gave way approaching the seven-sixteenths pole, and continued evenly. MARKET OF STOCKS raced in close attendance from the two path and lacked the needed late response. C F V TU BRUTUS reserved toward the back and failed to threaten. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
