GOING STREAKIN dueled outside of BROOKLYN CAN DANCE, put that rival away at the quarter, pole, went clear in upper stretch and held safe from a mild bid while under steady handling. TRUE CLASS tracked three wide in the second flight, moved up from that group on the turn, went after the leading pair approaching the quarter pole, came three-wide into the stretch, had some trouble with the lead change, hung, and had to settle for second. ECONOMIC HANGOVER was the inside horse of the tracking trio, saved ground throughout, and kept on well enough to claim the minor award. BROOKLYN CAN DANCE dueled inside of GOING STREAKIN from the start, then gave way near the quarter pole. CODA MIA broke best but ceded the lead after the initial furlong, struggled to keep pace on the turn and did not offer a late bid. COUNCILWOMAN JILLY was a little slow to get going, then between horses down the backstretch, and never fired. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
