SNOW KING dueled early on while two wide, raced in the three path into the lane, drew clear in the stretch, lugged out a bit nearing the sixteenth pole and held in the late stages. PROVE WORTHY trailed the field early on, swung into the six path entering the lane, rallied down the lane but was too late while up for place. DOWNTOWN CONNECTOR raced back early on, raced in the five path into the lane, made a bid in the stretch but flattened out late and lost place in the final stages. SKIPPER'S PRIDE chased the pace early on, raced in the two path into the lane and weakened late in the stretch run. COACH CAMPBELL dueled early on from the inside, was in the two path into the lane and gave way down the lane. THE RIDER OF DOWNTOWN CONNECTOR CLAIMED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF SNOW KING FOR INTERFERENCE IN THE STRETCH RUN BUT AFTER REVIEW BY THE STEWARDS THE CLAIM WAS DISALLOWED.
