TALE OF LADY MARIA tracked the early pace from the second flight then went up to press heading into the turn, dueled ALWAYS IN VOGUE into the bend and took a narrow lead at the quarter marker, dug in while battling ALWAYS IN VOGUE into the stretch, determinedly kept the runner-up at bay into the final sixteenth and held well for the win in deep stretch. ALWAYS IN VOGUE broke alertly and assumed early command, set the pace from the inside heading to the turn then came under pressure at the three-eighths, lost the lead to TALE OF LADY MARIA nearing the quarter marker then dueled that one to upper stretch, fought gamely to the final sixteenth but was denied for the win and bested the rest for the place. SPRING SPINNING lunged at the start and unhurried early on, loomed three wide nearing the quarter marker, drifted out to upper stretch, chased the leading pair into the final sixteenth, couldn't find more in deep stretch but held for the show. RUN MAMA RUN settled in the early stages, was well placed while between foes approaching the turn, got caught in a bit of traffic nearing the quarter marker and swung to the three path into upper stretch, chased the leaders into the final furlong, needed more late. INSTABRAT tracked the early pace from the second flight, lost ground along the turn, couldn't muster the needed late response. SONHO DE VERAO settled in the second flight, came under a drive approaching the turn, trailed to the quarter marker, no late response.
