FAENA close up to the early pace, pressured the pacesetter to the backstretch then took back and stalked three wide approaching the half-mile marker, angled inside into the far turn, re-rallied and took command nearing the top of the lane, took command and kept to task into the final furlong, edged away in deep stretch and proved best in the late stages. RED BERETTA assumed early command and showed the way to the first turn, pressured by FAENA to the backstretch then shook free of that rival and dictated terms to the half-mile, dueled TOODELIRIOUS (IRE) into the far turn, left the rail open nearing the top of the lane and was overtaken by a re-rallying FAENA, chased the winner in the stretch drive and held safely for the place. FREAK CITY unhurried and content to trail in the early going, was last nearing the quarter marker, rallied between rivals into the final furlong, was gaining into deep stretch and held late for the show. TARRAGON settled in the second flight to begin, got caught a bit in tight onto the backstretch and steadied approaching the half-mile pole, chased the leaders to the quarter marker, lacked the needed response into the stretch and finished evenly. TOODELIRIOUS (IRE) settled while saving ground early on, shifted to the two path leaving the half-mile then vied for the lead into the far turn, battled three wide to upper stretch, could not sustain her bid past mid-stretch and weakened.
