SWEET LILIBET settled mid-pack through the early stages of the race in the three path and took aim entering the far turn while coming out to the six path then closed up in the stretch to prove best. SEVENTEENSEVITYSIX was first away at the break and set the pace about two to three wide off the rail clear from the rest of the pack but was outfinished in the stretch while being a clear second best. DECREE tracked the pace from the two to three path but was no match for the top two while besting the rest. CHAMPAGNE ON ICE settled near the back of the pack early on and came four wide around the turn and improved mildly. QUEEN LEXI was settled mid-pack on the inside early on but faded in the stretch and was no menace. NEUTRAL CAUSE was settled off pace at the back and came five wide around the turn and swung widest into the upper but was no factor. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
