TRANSCENDENCE was bumped at the start and vied from the three path early then assumed command and drew clear while shifting to the inside, then drifted out a bit in the stretch while being clearly best. CAST YOUR SPELL vied from the two path early between rivals and shifted to the inside nearing the quarter pole, then drew ahead from the pack and was clearly second best while being no match for the winner. J. P INDY was placed mid-pack early on and settled back along the inside around the turn, then checked nearing the quarter pole while circling about five to six wide into the upper and got the show award. SISSY'S MAY settled at the back of the pack in the four path through most of the race and swung seven wide into the upper while improving mildly. LESOTHO vied early on from the inside and shifted back a bit then slightly steadied nearing the three furlongs marker and was on the heels of a rival nearing the quarter pole and checked outwards and bumped with MELEAH. MALEAH was bumped at the start and raced on near the back then advanced entering the turn through the four path, then was bumped again outwards nearing the quarter pole and weakened in the stretch. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
