GOLDEN ALE set a pressured pace from the inside and showed the way to prove best. WHATDOYOUTHINKMARK tracked the pace from the inside and tipped out into the stretch four wide then angled back in and rallied and was along for the place award. UNWORKABLE pressed the pace from the two path through most of the race but failed to sustain it's bid in the home stretch and settled for the show award. NOW THAT ICAN ROCK settled at the back and mildly improved in the stretch. COMING IN HOT raced on near the back in the four path and shifted up around the turn then came out six wide into the upper and flattened out. LIBERATE settled mid-pack in the three path and came between rivals through the turn then came out five wide into the upper and weakened. MISSION CONTROL trailed the field and was no factor. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate times.
