FREEDOM EMPIRE broke in at the start and crowded inner rivals, took early command and set a contested pace from the two path heading into the turn, met the bid of PAIRED EXCHANGE to upper stretch, dug in while holding that rival at bay into the final sixteenth, determinedly held late for the win. PAIRED EXCHANGE broke in at the start and crowded inner rivals, went up to stalk the early leaders then was well placed approaching the turn, loomed three wide along the bend, vied for the lead to upper stretch, couldn't get by the determined winner in the lane and was a clear second. BIG ROG pinballed and pinched back at the start, trailed in the early stages, advanced to the turn, coaxed two wide to the quarter marker, swung four wide to upper stretch, couldn't impact the leading pair into the final sixteenth, closed to be a clear third. HEY BATTER BATTER went up to contest the early pace from the inside, pressed into the turn and battled to upper stretch, couldn't keep pace into the final furlong and weakened in the late stages. STRIKE PRICE settled off of the early pace, trailed to the quarter marker, lacked a response to upper stretch, no factor. THE RIDER OF PAIRED EXCHANGE LOGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST FREEDOM EMPIRE, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE AT THE START. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THAT OBJECTION, AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.

AL MUSTANEERA rated off of the early pace then stalked to the backstretch, roused two wide into the far turn, made a quick move to take command and kicked clear at the quarter marker, drew off into upper stretch, kept task to the final sixteenth and held safely over the oncoming runner-up. PRIVATE MO vied for early command from the inside, went up to take the lead into the first turn, set a decent pace to the half-mile marker, overtaken by AL MUSTANEERA into the far turn, angled off of the rail and fought on into the lane, re-rallied late but couldn't catch the winner and was second best. MCKINZIE RIVER away in good order then took back, settled while saving ground to the backstretch, kept an inside path to the far turn then angled out but was caught a bit in tight behind PRIVATE MO into upper stretch, shifted back to the inside and chased at mid-stretch, couldn't keep pace with the top pair late and was an easy third. HULAH JAY broke alertly then was close up to the early lead while three wide, tracked the decent pace three deep into the backstretch, dropped back along the far turn and was empty in the stretch drive. OCEAN WINDOWS broke alertly then ceded the early lead, tracked the loose leader along the backstretch and gained ground on SO FAR SO GOOD into the turn, swung to the three path to upper stretch and vied for the lead at the furlong pole, dueled while on the left lead into the final sixteenth, held a narrow lead into deep stretch then dug in to prevail over the stubborn runner-up. SO FAR SO GOOD hustled to take early command, sprinted clear along the backstretch then dictated terms to the turn, carved out a solid pace while off of the rail nearing the quarter pole, met the bid of OCEAN WINDOWS into upper stretch, stubbornly battled past the furlong grounds, was outfinished in deep stretch and bested the rest. RYE SMILE hopped and broke in at the start and was last away from the gate, settled in the early stages, advanced while saving ground into the turn then kept an inside path to the stretch, couldn't find more to the final sixteenth but held clearly in the end for third. AADYA rated off of the early pace, raced widest along the backstretch then ran in pursuit from the two to three path into the turn, angled to the four to five path to upper stretch and gained at the furlong marker, lacked a final response and finished evenly. STAY FAITHFUL a bit slow away from the gate, lacked early speed then trailed into the turn, saved ground to the quarter pole, kept an inside path to the stretch and gained approaching the furlong marker, finished evenly in the late stages and failed to threaten.
