KARMA DIRECTOR showed speed, dueled pace inside, repelled foe stretch, held sway to the wire, proved best. BLACK CANDY settled inside, swung to the four path to upper stretch, finished well, up in time for the place. EL GAVILAN dueled pace two wide to the quarter marker, turned away nearing mid-stretch, yielded in the final sixteenth and nailed for the place at the wire, while just holding for the show. ENGLISH TIDE tracked the early pace from the second flight, saved ground into the turn, angled out to upper stretch, bid to the final sixteenth, outkicked, missed minor awards. SPOKE settled mid-pack, coaxed two to three wide to the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch, mounted a mild late rally. SAY IT AIN'T SO tracked the early pace from the second flight, chased two wide to the quarter marker, weakened stretch. NAGY AND DA BEARS bobbled then squeezed back at the start, lacked early speed, saved ground into the turn, kept an inside path to the stretch and did not factor late. MCVICKER allowed to settle, coaxed from the two path nearing the quarter marker, swung out to upper stretch then lacked a late bid. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
