WILD TAPIT dropped back after a level start, tipped out three-wide for the stretch run, and responded when set down and wore down the leader despite racing on the wrong lead through most of the stretch run. HIGHLY CREATIVE broke on top, assumed the early lead with a pair of rivals keeping close company to the outside, responded when challenged at the three-furlong pole, shrugged off both foes at the top of the stretch but could not hold off the late bid of the winner. ECONOMIC HANGOVER raced between horses in the tracking group, kept to the inside path and came under the crop in upper stretch, responded to move up into the third spot. DR. BELLA was the outside horse in the second flight, made a mild late bid, but was not good enough. BANNED FROM MIDWAY pressed the pace two-deep, remained in contention to mid-stretch, then weakened. WILDCAT DREAM pressed the pace three-wide, came under pressure approaching the quarter pole, and tired in the stretch. C F V TU BRUTUS raced with the trailing group for the first quarter mile, lost ground before the turn, and was not involved in the late stages. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
