VALIANT STRIKE bobbled at the start, set the pace along the inside around the first turn, got headed by an early challenger at the five furlong pole, chased around the far turn, re-rallied into the final furlong, bid inside of the leader at the sixteenth pole and prevailed. LIGHTNING SPEED pressed two to three wide, got outmoved by an outer bidder into the far turn, chased turning for home yet re-rallied to offer a late bid and gained place at the wire. SWEET KYLIE tracked from the two path, shifted out to the four path and progressed with a swift move into the far turn, led then drew clear passing the three furlong pole, but got caught by an inner bidder at the sixteenth pole, fought on yet lost place to an outer bidder at the wire. SMOOTH WHISKEY pursued from the four path, issued an early challenge to gain an advantage at the five furlong pole, crossed to the inside approaching the far turn, got headed by an outer bidder reaching the three furlong pole, proved no match and faded. MUSIC JEWEL failed to factor. RINGTHATBELL tracked from the three path then was done early. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
