HALTER BOY was mid field early on, racing along the inside, angled out around the turn, closing fast and drawing off from the field in mid stretch to be the easy winner. KAJUS was mid track early on, racing from the outside, made a steady gain down the backstretch and got up for second but was no match for the winner. GET ME ONE TOO was allowed to setting in the early goings, then offered a bid around the turn and got up for show. ENDOW was mid field early racing along the inside, then dropped back around the turn, angled out down the lane with a mild rally. IMPROBABLE CAUSE stalked the pace early from the outside, then dueled for the lead on the backstretch but gave way around the turn. ABSOLUTE ZERO was near the back early, racing along the rail, angled out in the stretch and offered a mild late effort. MR. MAC MIDNIGHT chased the pace early from the inside, dueled for the lead briefly into the turn and faded in the stretch drive. ALLKINDSOFTROUBLE made the early lead, dueled briefly down the backstretch and faded in the turn.
