MY ROMEO LIMA set the unpressured pace early, then was challenged slightly around the far turn, but hit the head of the lane, drawing off from the field and was ridden out at the wire. FROSTY THE SOLDIER stalked the pace early from the inside, then offered bid around the turn to get up for place but was no match for the winner. RAISON KARTER chased the pace early on, then rallied around the turn, moving into second down the lane, but faltered slightly in late stretch and held on to show. ROAD MINISTER trailed the field early on, then offered a mild rally in the stretch drive, passing tiring rivals. DOCTOR NASH was mid pack early, between horses but dropped back in the far turn. TIMELESS BOUNTY was near the back early, on the inside, then made a middle move down the backstretch and faded in the far turn.
