LONG SHORTS pressed the pace from between rivals racing four wide down the backside kept wide by the the inside pacesetter, bid leaving the quarter pole as the top trio moved to the lead, angled to the rail after passing the tiring pacesetter and rallied determinedly through the lane to take control late. JABRAN vied for the lead from five wide on the backside, pressed to take a brief lead turning for home, was outkicked in upper stretch to lose position, angled to the outside midway down the lane and ran-on to re-claim the place in deep stretch. WAUHATCHIE stalked the dueling pacesetters from six wide down the backstretch, rallied to engage the leaders at the top of the lane from four wide, rallied to the lead in midway down the lane and weakened in the final sixteenth. NOAHS ARK reserved off the pace through th turn and made a steady bid in the lane. ROGER MCQUEEN urged early to keep pace, raced near the rear of the field to the quarter pole and made mild rally in the lane without impact. MITHRIDATES set a pressured pace while racing wide in the four path down the backstretch, dropped to the inside while still setting a pressured pace through the turn, tired nearing the quarter pole dropping out of the pace duel, steadied briefly while tiring at the head of the stretch and faded in the lane. J W RUCKUS was through early after racing in early contention. THE TRAINER OF MITHRIDATES CLAIMED FOUL FOR INTERFERENCE BY THE WINNER AT THE HEAD OF THE STRETCH, UPON REVIEW THE STEWARDS MADE NO CHANGE.
