THE LAW set a pressured pace to the quarter pole, was no match for the winner and kept-on willingly in the stretch to hold the show. ANTHONY'S SPICE pressed the pace for a half and weakened in the stretch. ROSE DARLING reserved well off the pace, circled wide turning for home and showed some interest without impact in the lane. SANDRINHA LOVE raced mid-pack and failed to mount a closing bid. SPARE A DIME chased the leaders in contention down the backstretch and gave way.
