## Footnotes | View Glossary Of Terms

MY GRASS IS BLUE set the early pace while being well rated and off the rail, drew off in upper stretch while drifting out but was ridden out in the end. COACH CAMPBELL was settled in the early going, rallied three wide on the turn making a bid but was second best in late stretch. TOM'S SPIRIT chased the early pace while two wide then raced off the rail on the turn, made a bid then faltered in the stretch. FIRE WIRE was unhurried early then was inside in the stretch but was no threat. BETTERING bobbled at the start then settled, raced two wide on the turn then faltered in the drive. SAY IT AIN'T SO chased the early pace while two wide into the turn, was used up and gave way.
