SWAYBACK JACK, four deep chasing the pace around the turn, secured command approaching the eighth pole then drew out under steady handling. BANG A RANG chased the early pace, failed to keep up from the three path on the turn, angled out in upper stretch and offered a slight rally. KING OF KENTUCKY sped to the front, stayed in the two path around the turn, lost the lead in upper stretch and gave way the final sixteenth of a mile. READY PURSUIT, rank at the start, was outrun and raced in the three path on the turn. LILTONYTWOPHONES remained along the inner rail throughout and dropped back through the stretch.
