WASABI BEACH showed speed, stayed in the two path around the turn, drew off under vigorous rousing and lugged in near the sixteenth pole. COUSIN JOE , three wide on the turn, chased the winner and was best of the others. HE'S MY BOY raced in the two path on the turn and failed to menace. CLINTSBUCKEYE , along the inner rail entering the far turn, swung to the four path leaving the bend and passed a tired rival. LORDBETWENTOTHORNS showed speed along the rail and retreated through the stretch. SKIPTHEGUILTRIP chased the early pace along the rail, gave way on the turn and swung wide in upper stretch.
