A LOTTA DOUGH broke a step slowly then sped to the early lead, set a contested pace along the backstretch, shook free into the turn and carved out solid fractions to the quarter marker, kept to task into the lane and was ridden out to the wire to win as much the best. MOORE GOLD disputed the early pace from outside of A LOTTA DOUGH, was repelled into the turn and chased A LOTTA DOUGH to the quarter marker, was no match for the winner into the stretch drive but was a clear second. DANCER'S SHADOW broke out and crowded LUCKCREST at the start, was away in good order then took back off of the quick early pace, coaxed from the inside to upper stretch, couldn't make headway on the top pair in the stretch drive and held for third. LUCKCREST bothered by an inner foe at the start and last leaving the gate, lacked early speed, coaxed from the two to three path to upper stretch, ran evenly through the lane and was outfinished for third.
