BURNING LEAVES close up in the early stages, prompted the modest pace along the backstretch, went up to vie for the lead two wide into the far turn, battled with RACE DAY REBAL into the lane, wore down that foe into the final sixteenth then edged away late to prove best. RACE DAY REBAL sent for the early lead, took command and set a modest pace while prompted to the half-mile, met the bid of BURNING LEAVES at the quarter marker, came off of the rail into upper stretch then dug in into the drive, couldn't hold off the winner in the final sixteenth but held well late for second. BOBBY'S GIFT well placed while tracking the early leaders, chased three wide to the quarter marker then ran in pursuit of the top two into the stretch, mounted a late bid to the final sixteenth and missed for second, while holding for third. HEMP HEAVEN lunged then broke in at the start and was last away from the gate, settled while saving ground to the backstretch, kept an inside path to the far turn, found his best stride late but couldn't reel in the top three in deep stretch. THEO'S THUNDER settled to the backstretch run, coaxed two wide to upper stretch, angled widest while gaining into the final sixteenth but couldn't find enough in deep stretch and was outkicked. SANT' ANTIMO settled outside of rivals to the first turn, lagged into the backstretch and trailed to the far turn, showed good late interest but failed to threaten the leaders late.
