PALAGIO bore out at the start, settled back to far turn under good handling into the stretch and kept on in the stretch run with a gutsy effort to prevail. BEE CAT sharp speed to duel throughout, dug in through the stretch run but outgamed to the wire. RANCHO had inside speed while pressured to the stretch and weakened for the show spot. EXTRAVAGANT PRINCE broke sharp from inside lagged back to far turn, improved late. NICO'S DERBY RUN saved ground to no avail while evenly throughout. WHERE'S JACK off rail run to backstretch while never a menace throughout. THUBOOT had a troubled start from the gate, tried to keep up for half with nothing left and folded through the stretch run. LINARES CHILD (FR) good position inside to far turn, nothing left for the stretch.
