WRECK IT RUBY was near the front away from the gates, gaining command coming out of the first turn, then drew clear of the field down the backstretch and carried on to win easily. RUN IN GOLD was mid field early on, racing along the rail, then angled out for the stretch drive and rallied to get up for place. CLASSIC TIRAMISU trailed the field early, saving ground, then closed well up the rail to get up for third. GAMBI broke sharp and gained a brief lead, then pressed the pace down the backstretch but gave way down the lane. DYNAMO'S CODE stalked the pace early on, from the outside and dropped back in the far turn. RANDI RANDI RANDI was near the back, racing just off the rail, and had an even effort. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
