RYNO WRECKER was mid field early, racing on the outside, then angled in around the turn, to close up the rail and draw off from the field in late stretch for an easy win. VENEZUELAN FAITH got off slow away from the gates, trailing the field early, then circled around the outside with a rally down the lane, but was no match for the winner. SHRINER made the lead early, drawing clear around the turn, but faltered in late stretch to hold on for show. BULLSEYE BUN was near the back and offered a mild bid at the head of the lane, but flattened out late. NERVANA was mid pack early, racing along the rail, then dropped back around the turn, angled out in the stretch drive and improved position. TUSCALOOSA pressed the pace early from the outside and dropped back in the stretch drive. MANSION PARTY chased the pace, along the inside but gave way in the turn. PICCATATA PRINCE was in contention early, on the outside, then faded in the stretch.
