ILLINI roused to the front to take a pressured lead around the first turn then edged away to the top of the stretch then drew off to prove best while setting all the pace. FIRE WIRE showed no early speed then moved up from two wide on the turn, tipped in to make a rail bid in the stretch to prove second best. FOLLOW YOUR DREAM was forwardly placed from two wide through the turn then made a mild bid and held the show. BAMBY BOOM was hustled away from the gate, stalked the pace while racing wide throughout and giving an even effort. LOBO SALVAJE vied for the lead from two wide to the top of the stretch then gave way. MISTER ROSSO trailed early and passed tired one. PAYNTER CITY raced in the middle of the pack while saving ground down the backstretch then tipped out to two wide around the turn but was not a threat. TUSCALOOSA raced off the pace on the inside down the backstretch then faded on the turn and was outrun.
