RANCHO stalked the early pace and was well placed to the turn, chased three wide to the quarter marker, made a quick move to upper stretch then vied for the lead nearing the furlong grounds, took command into the final sixteenth and edged away in the late stages. PAPA ALDEN showed good speed, vied for the early then assumed command and set the pace from the inside into the turn, drifted to the two path into upper stretch then showed the way to the furlong marker, met the bid of RANCHO to the sixteenth-pole, was turned away into deep stretch and held safely for second. OPTIMISTIC INCOME raced close up to the early pace while inside of runners, got shuffled back a bit approaching the turn, chased from the inside to upper stretch, was outkicked past the furlong marker and held at the wire for third. BALAM broke awkwardly and was off slowly, trailed to the turn, swung six wide to upper stretch, finished well and just missed for third. CAN OF CORN crowded at the start and off slowly, advanced two to three wide along the turn, swung to the four path into upper stretch and found his best stride late. FOX CREEK was a bit erratic away from the start and checked in the early stages, recovered and chased from the inside nearing the quarter marker, ran in pursuit to mid-stretch and could not muster a final response. RUNAWAY KITTEN crowded at the start and was off slowly, settled off of the early pace and saved ground to the turn, angled three wide along the bend, ran in pursuit to upper stretch and lacked a late rally. ATOMIC SNOW away in good order, pressed the pace four deep heading to the turn, kept close attendance to PAPA ALDEN nearing the quarter marker, was outkicked into upper stretch then gave way through the final furlong. COCKTAILS N DREAMS forwardly placed early on while between runners, was

caught in tight and took up at the three-eighths marker, lost position along the bend and trailed the rest of the way. THE RIDER OF COCKTAILS N DREAMS LODGED AN OBJECTION AGAINST THE RIDER OF RANCHO, CLAIMING INTERFERENCE ALONG THE TURN. THE STEWARDS DISALLOWED THE OBJECTION AND RULED THERE WOULD BE NO CHANGE.
