FIERY CROSS broke alertly and sent for the early lead, made all of the pace to the second turn, met the bid of GO CHICAGO nearing the top of the lane, dug in through the stretch and lasted for a determined win. GO CHICAGO tucked in just behind the early leader, was well placed while saving ground along the backstretch, tipped two wide and bid into the far tur, dueled outside of FIERY CROSS into the stretch, fought gamely to the final sixteenth but couldn't get by the winner and was a well clear second. NOBLE COURT settled mid-pack to begin, moved up to be well placed while three wide nearing the half-mile marker, chased the leading pair into the stretch, couldn't find more in the final furlong but held for third at the wire. STILLNOHASSLEJJ unhurried in the early going, trailed at the quarter marker, weaved through rivals through the stretch drive, found his best stride late and just missed for third. PUNKIN BOY crowded and in tight at the start, settled outside to the backstretch, gained ground three wide nearing the far turn, swung to the four path to upper stretch and finished evenly in the drive. SOUTHERN SOUL allowed to settle, saved all of the ground to the second turn, tipped to the two path to upper stretch then passed tiring foes in the late stages. FIRESTORM DANCER was forwardly placed while saving ground early, kept an inside path while mid-pack along the backstretch, got caught in traffic into the far turn, angled two then three wide to upper stretch, lacked the needed response to the final furlong and weakened. JAKES CHANNEL broke a bit awkwardly then settled to the first turn, saved ground to the backstretch then raced in the two path nearing the half-mile marker, angled out and was coaxed four wide to the quarter marker, swung widest to upper stretch and lacked a late rally. COPAL prominent in the

early running, tracked the pacesetter along the backstretch while between runners, dropped back into the far turn, couldn't find more in the stretch drive and gave way.
