SPARE A DIME pressed the pace three across to the turn, challenged two across, assumed command and drew clear near the eighth pole and held off the late charge of GENERAL GINNY. GENERAL GINNY lagged early, closed under steady urging and was gaining late. MS. THE LAW set a pressured pace to mid stretch, faltered and held for show. LONG BLACK VEIL raced in the second flight along the inside, angled out in the upper stretch and failed to rally. ECONOMIC HANGOVER pressed the pace while racing between horses, was taken back from tight quarters on the turn and stopped.
