SOME R BLESSED set the pace and held well in a driving finish. JUANITA'S EXPRESS brushed at the start, was unhurried early, rallied around the turn, swung wide entering the stretch, found his best stride late and got up at the wire for place. ASSIDUOUSLY (GB) raced close to the pace along the inside, bid off the rail leaving the turn, moved up to threaten, couldn't keep up, yielded and was caught for second. ENGLISH CHALLENGE pressed the pace while racing between horses, dropped back on the turn, got through along the rail entering the stretch, bid and hung. FROSTY THE SOLDIER pressed the pace between horses to the second turn and leveled off. LONG SHORTS was never far off the pace, raced outside, weakened in the drive and faded. SUCCESSION GOLD broke slowly, was slow into stride, raced in the back, swung wide leaving the turn and offered a mild bid to improve position. PRICHARD brushed at the start, raced mid pack, had nothing left for the drive and faded. KENNEL CLUB was slow early, swung wide leaving the turn and lacked a response. INDY LYON pressed the pace while racing four wide to the second turn, bid, came up empty and gave way.
