WAVE SKIPPER tracked the pace three wide into the far turn, slipped inside rivals leaving the quarter pole, worked into range angled out leaving the sixteenth post, rallied in time to claim the victory. SPRING SPINNING shuffled along the rail into the first turn, under heavy restraint stalked the leader inside into the far turn, given the queue took the lead leaving the three eighths marker, held a clear advantage approaching the furlong marker, took a peak back in search of competition in deep stretch, stayed on willingly nailed under the wire. ANIMAL FRIES bobbled at the start, quickly took control of the tempo leaving the club house turn, set the pace along the rail into the far turn, yielded to SPRING SPINNING around the far turn, under an all-out drive held on late to save the show. PEACHES POINT saved ground off the pace down the backside, put to task along the rail into the far turn, angled out five wide into the lane, evened out lost the show under the wire. CHAMPAGNE ON ICE trailed throughout. This race had a timing discrepancy or malfunction and was re-timed using video technology to arrive at the most accurate time.
